Thank You for your interest in the Lost Angels Work Program, below is an outline of the steps to be completed for a successful and timely enrollment. These steps can and should be taken simultaneously. Contact Yanelie Banegas at secretary@lostangelscp.org if you have any questions or concerns at any point.

Please note: Completing these steps does not guarantee you a spot in the work program, you will still have to go through the interview process and receive notice of acceptance to the work program. These are simply requirements that will have to be completed upon acceptance and by the first day of class.

Lost Angels Work Program Enrollment Process:

1. Submit Inquiry Form through our website to establish initial contact
2. We will reach out and schedule a phone call with you to complete a basic intake.
3. We will host an in person mass interview, inviting every applicant to our facility for an opportunity to get to know you better, assess barriers, and check the progress of the steps you were given. A date and time will be provided to you at a later time. You will receive notice of acceptance/denial to the program within a week following interview day.

AJCC Enrollment Process

1. Register on Caljobs at <http://www.caljobs.ca.gov/> and complete the Pre WIOA application within the website. You will need to upload photos of documents such as **Social Security, ID/DL, HS Diploma, Birth Certificate, and men will have to provide proof of registration to selective services.**
2. No further action is required until you are accepted into the program. Please keep those documents in a safe place as they are required to complete enrollment upon acceptance.

LACOE Enrollment Process

1. Complete LACOE training application. Return to smith_vendon@lacoedu CC: secretary@lostangelscp.org
2. A phone screening with Vendon Smith will be scheduled.
3. You will be invited to an informational meeting via Zoom, where we will discuss details about the program and answer any questions you may have.

GAIN/GROW Enrollment Process:

1. Go onto <https://dpss.lacounty.gov/> and select "Apply for Benefits Now." You may also download the DPSS mobile app and apply through the app.
2. You will be prompted to create an account before continuing. You will then have to fill out an application. If you **DO NOT** have children: apply for General Relief. If you **DO** have children: apply for Calworks and Calfresh.
3. After submitting an application, it is very important to answer all phone calls you may receive. This could be your case worker trying to reach out to verify some information prior to accepting your application. This is required.

We strongly encourage you to download the DPSS mobile app available on the App Store and Google Play to fast track your application. You are able to upload photos of documents they ask for as opposed to mailing them in.

Suggested Order/Checklist

- Complete an over the phone intake with Lost Angels
 - Register on CalJobs and submit the Pre-WIOA application. Upload required documents
 - Fill out and return the manufacturing application by email to smith_vendon@lacoed.edu cc secretary@lostangelscp.org
 - Apply for benefits on dpss.lacounty.gov. A successful application is required. Be attentive to any phone calls, emails, mail, or notifications you may receive.
 - Phone screening with Vendon Smith
 - Informational Zoom Meeting
 - Mass in person interview
- The phone screening and informational meeting with Vendon Smith will come once he receives a manufacturing application from you.
 - We will be checking your progress of checkboxes 1-4 at interviews.
 - Mass in person interview will come last. We will reach out to give you a date and time to come to our facility and be interviewed. You will hear back regarding acceptance/denial to program within a week after interview day.
